Sept 22	Students will receive account details for Get Into (the website used for college applications) and should begin to complete the profile section.				
	Students to start researching college courses via Get Into and college websites.				
Oct - Nov 22	Attend open evenings and events. Strongly recommended.				
Nov 22	Predicted grades uploaded to Get Into.				
Dec 22 - Jan 23	Students to apply to chosen colleges, it is strongly recommended to have at least on back up option.				
* Please note that Greenhead College applications are done through their website. They have a 2-stage application process and the 1st stage deadline is 2nd December 22.					
Jan 23	Mock Interviews take place in school.				
Feb - March 23	College interviews take place.


